

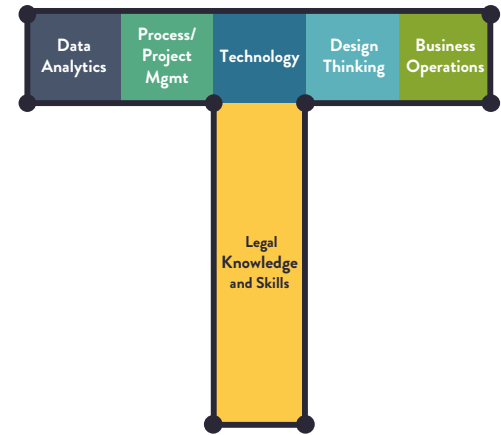
WHAT IS IFLP?

WHY WAS IT CREATED?

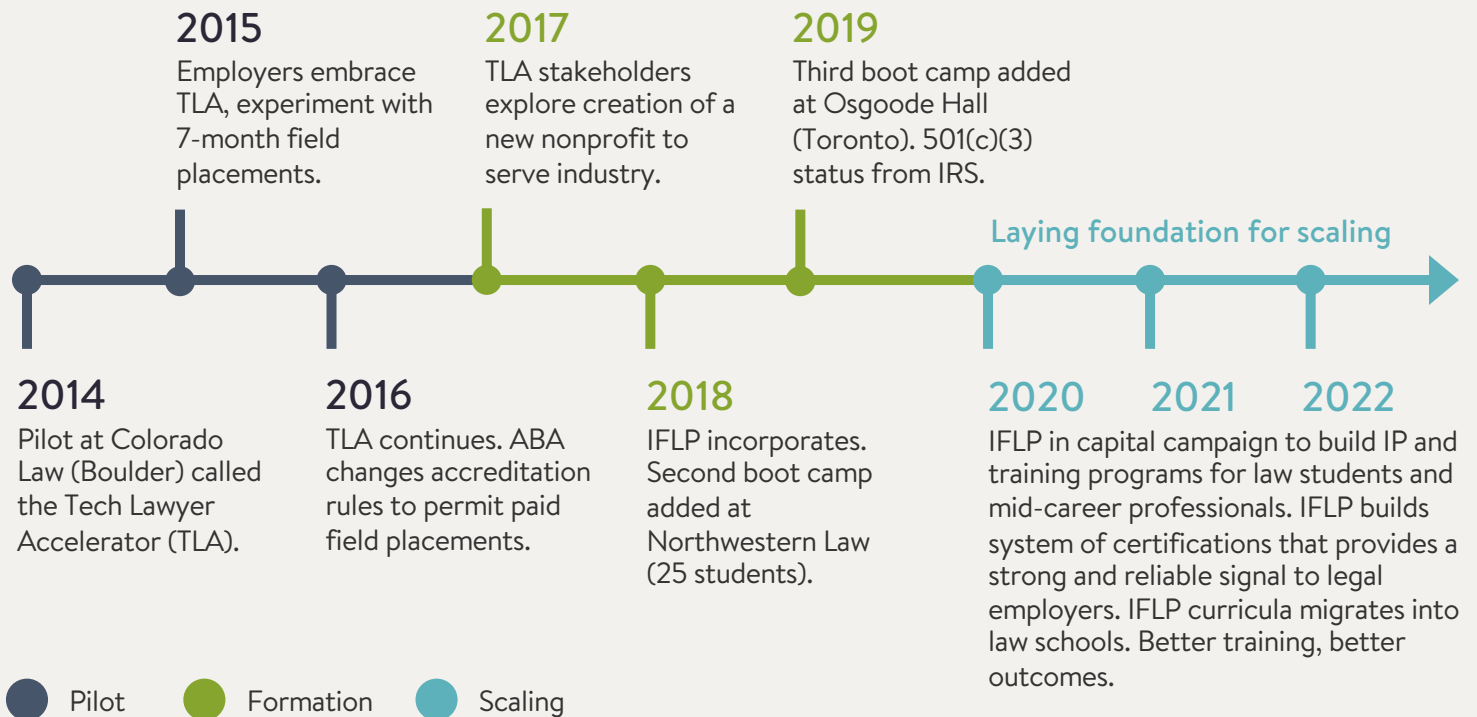
To produce more legal professionals who have a combination of legal knowledge and the know-how and methodology of other disciplines, such as data analytics, process/project management, technology, design thinking, and business operations ('T-shaped' legal professionals). Without dramatic upskilling of lawyers, the legal profession will struggle to control costs and effectively manage growing legal complexity. IFLP fills this need by building curricula that are designed to be high impact, time efficient, and highly cost effective.

CAN TRADITIONAL LAW SCHOOLS FILL THIS NEED?

No, not in a timely fashion. The professionals who are building out this new body of knowledge are located in practice and are in short supply. Competition among law schools will fragment this very limited talent base, reducing opportunities for collaboration and standardization. A better solution is to build very high quality and cost-effective curricula and training programs that can be scaled to law schools, law students, and mid-career professionals.
